### **Purposes of the processing**

## **6. Regular disclosures of personal data**

The names of the participants of the events will be disclosed from the register to the Council of Tampere Region, the financier of the project.

## **7. Data storage periods**

The data will be stored for 10 years after the end of the project (12/2031).
