

Entrepreneur's income statement

In addition to the statement of assets, entrepreneurs must provide the following documents to the child welfare supervisor about one week before the appointment:

- an extract from the Trade Register and a list of companies associated with the person
- articles of association/bylaws and list of shareholders
- last tax decision (personal and business, if separate)
- an up-to-date statement of the previous and current year's income, e.g. your most recent pay slip, if it shows your accrued income for the previous and current year with an itemised breakdown
- your company's account-specific income statement and balance sheet for the previous and current financial year. In addition to the entrepreneur's income from salary and wages income, the certificate must explain all fringe benefits and expenses reimbursed by the company
- an accountant's certificate of the amount of owner's withdrawals in the case of a sole proprietorship
- your company's bank account details
- decisions on any business subsidies awarded
- change and termination notification if your business activity has recently ended

If your company has not yet been active for a full year, then an account-specific income statement and balance sheet are required for as long a period as possible.
